

Pollinators of Wisconsin



Ruby Throated Hummingbird (*Trochilidae sp.*)

- Migrates to Wisconsin from Central America
- Key pollinators of wildflowers in the continental U.S.
- May visit 1,000 - 3,000 flowers per day to maintain caloric intake
- Pollen on their beak and body and breeze from their wings aids pollination
- Usually visit red-colored flowers
