'Firefly Sunshine'

Achillea

One of the very best Yarrows for lasting color throughout the summer. Bright yellow flowers contrast with dark gray green foliage. Upright habit. Height: 28-30" | Width: 24-28" | Zones: 3-8



'Serendipity'

Allium

A long blooming, drought and deer resistant perennial. Globe-like purple flowers appear for many weeks in later summer. Attractive seedheads follow. Height: 15-20" | Width: 15-20" | Zones: 4-8



'String Theory'

Amsonia

A compact version of industry standard *A. hubrichtii*. Less chlorotic than *A. hubrichtii* thanks to hybrid background with similar brilliant fall color.

Height: 18-22" | Width: 32-36" | Zones: 4-9



'Storm Cloud'

Amsonia tabernaemontana

Comparable to Baptisia with similar longevity and tolerance to heat and drought. One of the earliest perennials to emerge in spring.

Height: 24-30" | Width: 38-42" | Zones: 4-9



DECADENCE® 'Lemon Meringue'

Baptisia

Very compact and carefree, longer flower spikes sit on top of the plant rather than within the plant.

Height: 3' | Width: 3' | Zones: 4-9



'Jack of Diamonds'

Brunnera macrophylla

A deer resistant perennial that tolerates dry shade! Massive leaves reach more than 12" wide. Excellent disease resistance ensuring 3 season performance.

Height: 14-16" | Width: 28-32" | Zones: 3-8



'Paint the Town Fuchsia'

Dianthus

Much longer lived in the landscape with reliable performance in Northern and Southern zones. Earlier and far more prolific than traditional cultivars.

Height: 6-8" | Width: 16-18" | Zones: 4-9



Tuscan Gold™

Heliopsis helianthoides

Compact and sturdy, excellent disease resistance, free flowering. Multiple rows of petals on each flower for longer lasting color.

Height: 24-32" | Width: 20-24" | Zones: 4-9



PRIMO® 'Mahogany Monster'

Heuchera

Extremely vigorous and rugged - even in full sun! Rich red color. Long-lived in the landscape when sited correctly.

Height: 12-16" | Width: 22-28" | Zones: 4-9



SUMMERIFIC® 'Berry Awesome'

Hardy Hibiscus

Densely compact, rounded habit - rather than vase shape - massive 7-8" flowers along stem rather than just at top.

Height: 4' | Width: 41/2-5' | Zones: 4-9



SHADOWLAND® 'Diamond Lake'

Hosta

Large, showy blue hosta with good vigor and sun tolerance. Holds its blue color for a long time.

Height: 24-30" | Width: 48-54" | Zones: 3-9



AMAZING DAISIES® Daisy May®

Leucanthemum superbum
Free flowering, heavy repeat blooms.
Height: 12-24" | Width: 10-14" | Zones: 5-9



'Cat's Meow'

Nepeta faassenii

Tidy, dense habit that keeps its shape all season long.

Height: 17-20" | Width: 24-36" | Zones: 3-8



'Cat's Pajamas'

Nepeta

Compact, early blooming hybrid *Nepeta* perfect for the front of the border. Long blooming, deer and rabbit resistant perennial.

Height: 12-14" | Width: 18-20" | Zones: 3-8



PRAIRIE WINDS® 'Apache Rose'

Panicum virgatum

Midsize; more dense and upright habit; rosy red panicles rather than tan.

Height: 4' | Width: 21/2' | Zones: 4-9



PRAIRIE WINDS® 'Totem Pole'

Panicum virgatum

Tall, slender Panicum. Rigidly upright selection that resists flopping. Narrow base makes it easy to fit into small spaces or pair with other plants.

Height: 6' | Width: 21/2' | Zones: 4-9



'Denim 'n Lace'

Perovskia atriplicifolia

Stronger stems, stays compact, more upright tidy habit. Not prone to running about or sprawling through the landscape like the species.

Height: 28-32" | Width: 34-38" | Zones: 4-9



COLOR SPIRES® 'Violet Riot'

Salvia nemorosa

More concentrated show of vivid blooms; more dense habit; more upright stems; more consistent rebloom.

Height: 22" | Width: 20-24" | Zones: 3-8



PRAIRIE WINDS® 'Blue Paradise'

Schizachyrium scoparium

Elegant vase-shaped habit holds its upright form even through the snow and wind of winter.

Height: 3-3½' | Width: 2' | Zones: 3-9



ROCK 'N ROUND® 'Pure Joy'

Sedum

Perfectly rigid dome shape.

Height: 10-12" | Width: 16-20" | Zones: 3-9
